Arisaig Hotel is situated in the village looking across Arisaig Bay towards the isles of Eigg and Muck. The hotel dates back to the Jacobite era, originally built as a Coaching Inn around 1720.

The hotel comprises 13 bedrooms (2 single, 6 double, 3 twin, 2 family), all tastefully furnished and decorated, each with ensuite facilities (either bath or shower). All rooms are centrally heated and have a direct dial telephone, remote control colour television, coffee and tea making facilities.

Most bedrooms have sea views.  
All bedrooms are non-smoking.



Families are very welcome as we have two family rooms and hold a children's certificate in the lounge bar. Our playroom is well equipped with a variety of toys and games to amuse children of all ages.



The hotel is fully licensed and has 2 bars offering a range of around 70 malt whiskies. Live music is a regular feature during the summer months. Morning coffee and afternoon tea are served daily in the lounge, accompanied by delicious home-made scones. The cuisine here is varied - ranging from Lunches in our 2 bars to Evening meals in the restaurant and bars.
