

Leven House, B&B Arisaig



Leven House is a recently built family home set in its own spacious grounds and has magnificent views of mountains and lochs. It is ideal for a relaxing break or as a base for hill-walking, touring Ardnamurchan or cruising expeditions to explore the islands. It has two large well-furnished bedrooms, each with TV and hospitality tray and luxury en suite bathroom. Scottish Tourist Board 4 Stars.

The surrounding countryside and sea-shore have numerous tracks and paths for walkers and offer artists many varied and unique subjects and settings. A ten minute walk will take you to Prince's Beach and the Atlantic Ocean, with the remains of a vitrified fort, and in under an hour you can reach the hill-top with its breath-taking panorama of mountains, including Ben Nevis on a clear day, lochs, sea and the Islands of Skye, Eigg, Muck and Rum.



Red deer frequent the fields and forests along with foxes, badgers and pine martens. Eagles fly overhead and otters and seals are found on the shore.

The house is easily accessible by road (just off the main A830 road, 3 miles east of Arisaig) and rail (1 mile from Beasdale railway station - turn immediately right after the red telephone box).
